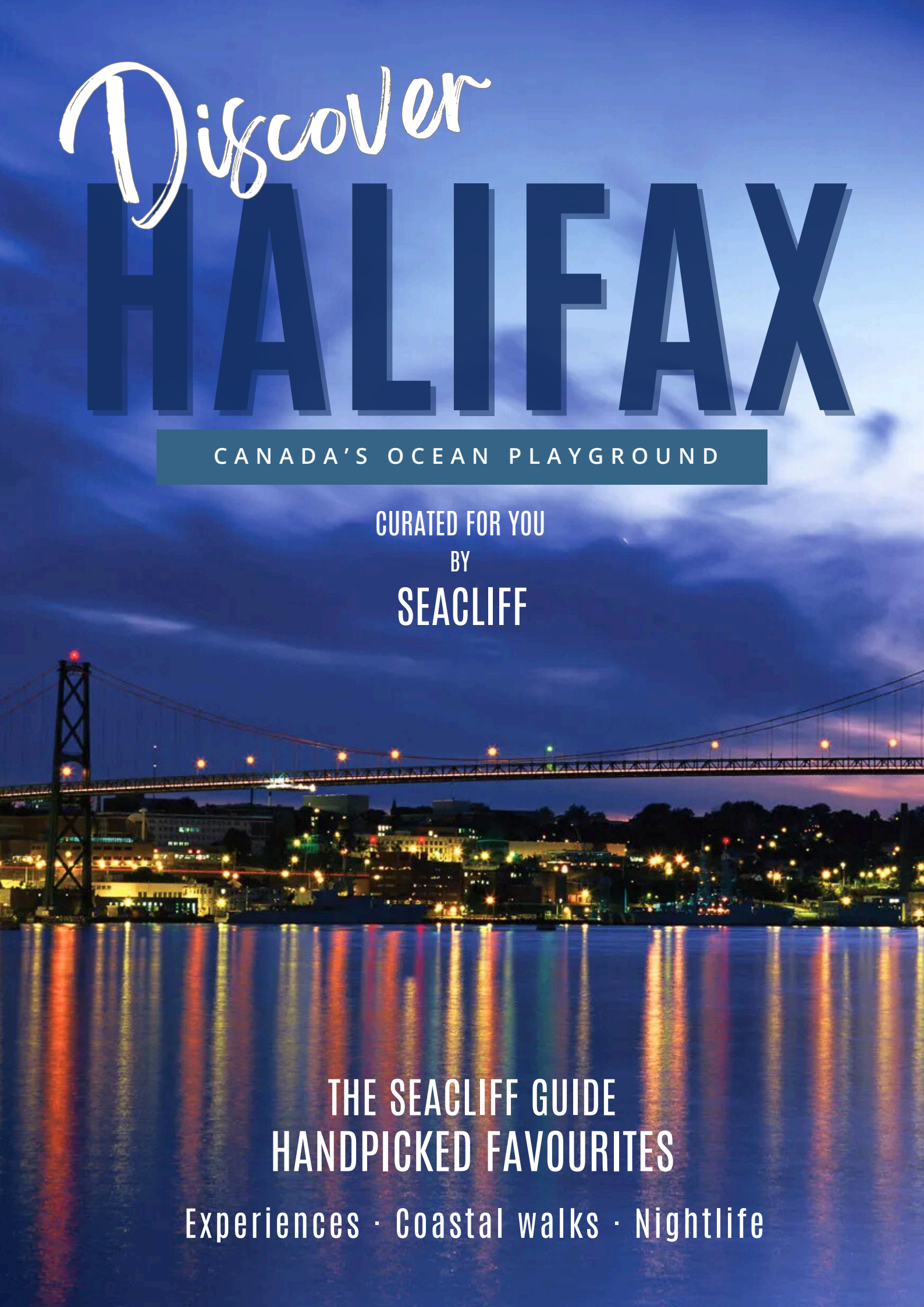

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PEGGY'S COVE

45-50 minute scenic drive

Seacliff Tip: Visit at sunrise or sunset for the most magical light and a quieter, more intimate experience.

A Seacliff favourite and one of Nova Scotia's most iconic coastal destinations.

Peggy's Cove is known for its historic lighthouse, sweeping granite rocks, and crashing Atlantic waves.

The scenic drive from Seacliff is part of the magic. Stroll the village, browse artisan shops, and capture one of Canada's most photographed views.

WHERE THE CITY FADES AWAY

CRYSTAL CRESCENT BEACH

A Seacliff favourite and one of Nova Scotia's most stunning white-sand beaches. Crystal Crescent offers turquoise water, rolling dunes, and three beaches connected by a spectacular coastal trail. Perfect for long walks, ocean swims, and golden-hour sunsets.

EXPLORE HALIFAX IN 48 HOURS

DAY 1

MORNING

Grab breakfast as you stroll the 4-kilometre Halifax waterfront boardwalk, exploring museums and shops as you go. If visiting on a weekend, pick up breakfast at the Halifax Seaport Farmers' Market (Saturdays and Sundays) or the Halifax Brewery Farmers' Market (Saturdays).

AFTERNOON

After brunch/lunch on a patio overlooking the harbour, enjoy a Halifax Harbour boat tour aboard the Tall Ship Silva, Harbour Hopper, or with J. Farwell Sailing Co. Then, head up to Spring Garden Road for boutique shopping.

EVENING

Liven up your night at one of the many nightlife hotspots and sample a local craft beer as you tap your toes along to the live music.



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EXPLORE HALIFAX IN 48 HOURS

DAY

2

MORNING

Stroll the Halifax Public Gardens, a green oasis in the heart of the city, followed by watching a rousing re-enactment of 19th-century military activities at the Halifax Citadel National Historic Site.

AFTERNOON

Explore town on a guided bike tour with I Heart Bikes or rent a bike for an independent adventure. Foodies will enjoy spending the afternoon sampling local eats with Taste Halifax Food & Beer Tours.

EVENING

Take in a production of Shakespeare by the Sea in Point Pleasant Park, then enjoy dinner at 2 Doors Down, Bar Sofia, Lot Six Bar & Restaurant, or for exceptional seafood try The Five Fishermen Restaurant & Grill or Press Gang Restaurant & Oyster Bar.

End the night at the The BG – Halifax Beer Garden as the sun sets over the harbour or at a favourite pub with live music.
